## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CURRITUCK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AMENDING CHAPTER 9, ARTICLE I OF THE CURRITUCK COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ADDING SECTION 9-12 PROHIBITING THE INTENTIONAL RELEASE OF BALLOONS WITHIN CURRITUCK COUNTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §153A-121 a county may by ordinance define, regulate, prohibit, or abate acts, omissions, or conditions detrimental to the health, safety, or welfare of its citizens and the peace and dignity of the county; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §153A-132.1, a county is authorized to enact ordinances governing the removal, method or manner of disposal, depositing or dumping any trash, debris, garbage, litter, discarded cans or receptacles or any waste matter whatsoever within the county; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §153A-145.3, counties may, by ordinance, define, prohibit, regulate, or abate acts, omissions, or conditions upon the State's ocean beaches, and in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the public, regulate, restrict, or prohibit the placement, maintenance, location, or use of equipment, personal property, or debris upon the State's ocean beaches; and

WHEREAS, the release of balloons pose a serious threat to the county's environment, wildlife, and utility infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Currituck, North Carolina as follows:

PART I. The Code of Ordinances, Currituck County, North Carolina is amended by adding Section 9-12 to Chapter 9, Article I to read as follows:

## Sec. 9-12. Release of balloons prohibited.

(a) For purposes of this section:

Balloon means a flexible, nonporous bag made from materials such as, but not limited to, rubber, latex, polychloroprene, mylar, or nylon fabric that can be inflated or filled with gas or fluid, such as helium, hydrogen, nitrous oxide, oxygen, air, or water, and then sealed at the neck of the bag.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, nonprofit organization, or corporation to knowingly and intentionally release, participate in the release of, intentionally cause to be released, to litter by abandoning and not properly disposing of any type of balloon inflated with a liquid, air or gas within the county, any waters within the zoning jurisdiction of the county, or the beach and/or dune areas within the county.

(c) The following are not violations of this Section:

1	(1) <u>Balloons released by a person on behalf of a governmental agency or pursuant</u>	
2	to a governmental contract for scientific or meteorological purposes;	
3	(2) Hot air balloons that are r	recovered after launching; and
4	(3) Balloons released inside a building or structure that do not make their way	
5	into the open air.	
6	(4) Accidental release of balloons	
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8	(d) Penalty. Any person found to be in violation of this section shall be subject to a civi	
9	penalty in the amount of \$50.00 for each violation.	
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12	PART II. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are	
13	severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be	
14	declared unconstitutional or invalid by the valid judgment or decree of a court of competent	
15	jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases,	
16	clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance.	
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17	PART III. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby	
18	repealed.	
19	PART IV. This ordinance is effective upon adoption.
